and provide the following documents:**

- Your child's birth certificate and Immunization Record
- Social security card
- Parent/guardian's driver's license
- Proof of residency (Must be in the Frenship ISD boundaries)

Any of the following:

Current Water, Gas or Electric Bill

Current Lease

(Must be in parent or guardian's name)

**Pre- K:** Current Pay Stub or SNAP verification letter

- Birth Certificates are \$22.00

The Frenship ISD State Funded Pre-K requires that a child qualifies based on standards set by the Texas Education Agency. To be eligible for enrollment in a Pre-K class, a child must be four years of age on September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year and **must meet one of the following criteria:**

- One or both parents are Active Military
- Parent/Guardian was killed or injured while on Active Military Duty
- Child speaks English as a Second Language
- Child is or has been under the conservatorship of Child Protective Services (CPS) – Form 2085 Required
- Qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch
- Child qualifies as homeless

**Frenship ISD now offers Tuition Based Pre-K for students that do not meet the state qualifications.**
